

Students not returning to school

The Province of Nova Scotia believes that it is safe for all students to return to school at this time. There is a plan in place for both increases in cases of COVID-19 locally and provincially. The first plan includes partial closure of schools to grades 9-12, where these students would work from home, supported by online learning. If there is a total closure of schools, then all students would be working from home using online and, possibly some offline learning systems for those with poor or no internet connectivity.

Both of these plans include online components and work being provided to students at home.

The full return-to-school option does not provide for work packages to be sent home at this time.
