Academic Achievement Awards

Highest Overall Average in Grade 12

Highest Mark in each respective Grade 12 subject, (i.e.: English 12, etc.)

Honours (with Distinction) - Recognition will be given to students having achieved an average of 90% or above in 7 subjects

Honours - Recognition will be given to students having achieved an average between 85% and 89% in 7 courses.

*Students must take 7 or more courses in their grade 12 year to qualify for Honours or Honours with Distinction.
